There is no "right" or "wrong" way — follow your light.

- 3. We recommend that there be no charge or fee required by any "Dragon Line Project."
- Having support available for people viewing the display is important. You also may wish to build some type of support for yourselves into the structure.
- 5. Panel-making sessions are very helpful and help build community.
