(The Dragon Panel Project is for very large scale installations, The Dragon-Line is easier to manage.)

**Do you want to honor a person of color who is not well-known who did something amazing?**

~Make a multi-colored panel for them!

**Anyone can do a Project!**

All you need are foam core or cardboard panels, glue and a little imagination. There is no "right" or "wrong" way.

— Make it your own!

~Make a head and tail, attach them all together with "velcro" or hang them on a line with clothespins, TA - DA!

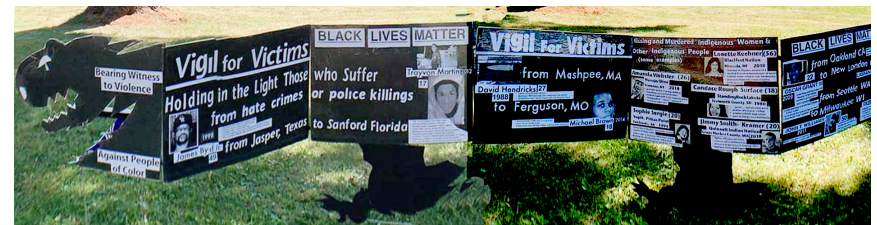

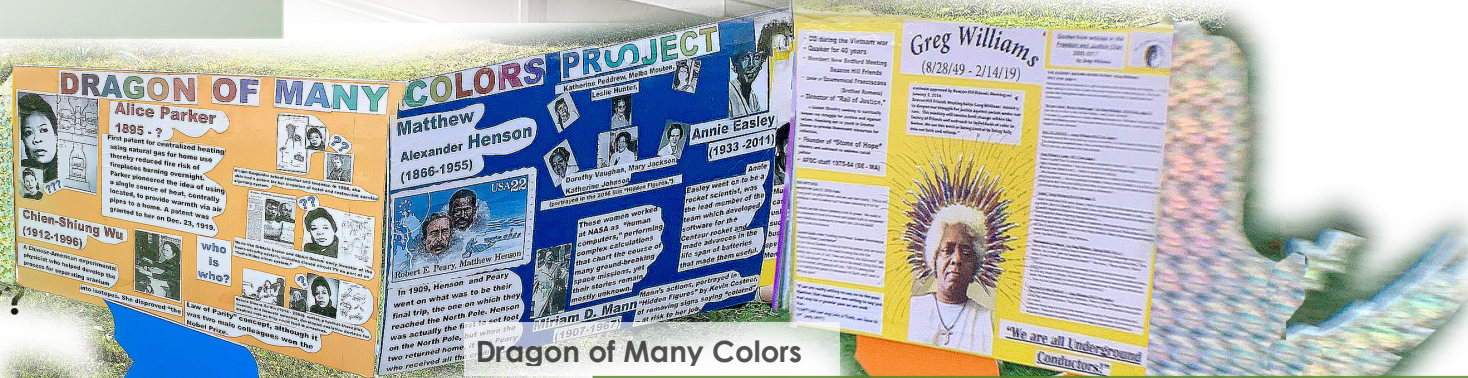
